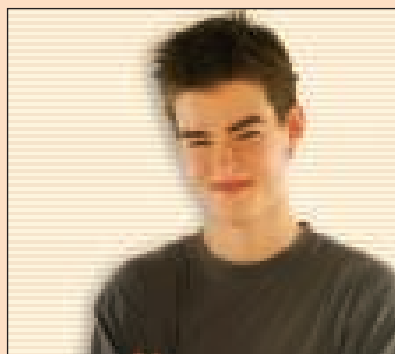

- 1 'I live in St Petersburg in the west of Russia. I'm 15 and I live with my parents and brother in a small flat.
- 2 On weekdays, I get up at 7.30 in the morning. I usually wear jeans with a sweatshirt or pullover, and trainers. I walk to school – it's very near my home and we don't have a car. School starts at 8.30am and ends at 2pm. We have six 45-minute lessons a day with a 20-minute break. I study maths, science, history, art, Russian, English and French – my favourite subjects are English and French. I like school, and I have lots of friends there.
- 3 After school I go home for dinner. We usually have soup, and we often have *blinis* – pancakes – with fish and sour cream. They're my favourite food. I do my homework in the evening and I usually go to bed at 11pm.

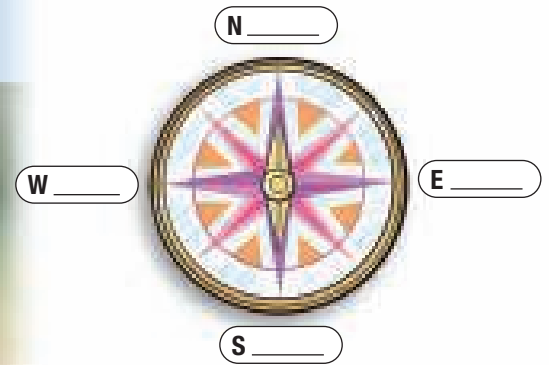


Marcelo

- 1 I'm 14 and I live in the city of São Paulo, in the south-east of Brazil. We have a big flat, but we're a big family – I have two brothers and three sisters.
- 2 I get up at 5.30am and catch the bus to school at 6.30. School starts at 7am and ends at 12 noon. We have six lessons every day and we study maths, science, Portuguese, English, Spanish, geography, history, computer studies and gymnastics. Our lessons are 40 minutes long. After the third lesson we have a 30-minute break and I buy a snack. I don't like school – I think it's boring. We wear a uniform: shorts or trousers, and T-shirts with the school's name on.
- 3 I have lunch at home at 1pm. We usually have meat with rice, and then fruit – we have lots of fruit in Brazil. But my favourite food is pizza. After lunch, I do my homework and in the evening I usually watch TV. I go to bed early, at half past nine.
